

# Beaver Valley Artists' Juried Exhibition Prospectus 2011

**The exhibition is open to all Beaver Valley Artist members in good standing** (paid-up dues) You may pay your dues when you submit your artwork entries. Individual dues: \$25 Family dues: \$30. (There is a \$5 late fee included when paying dues after Nov. 31st.

- Work must be completed within last three years.
- Work must be original in concept, design and not created under other's instruction or workshop.
- Works must be framed and ready to hang (wired- no sawtooth hangers)
- Paintings must be completely dry.

• To qualify for any award, members must have attended at least 2 meetings during the current year from September 2010 through March 2011. (Meeting attendance consists of both the business meeting and program)

- Works must not have been shown in any previous Beaver Valley Artists exhibitions.
- All media are accepted.
- Works that do not meet the above requirements will be refused.

**Delivery Dates:** Friday, March 25th, 10 am - 2 pm; Saturday, March 26th, 10 am - 12 noon.

**No entries will be accepted after 12 noon on Saturday, March 26th. The doors will be closed.**

**Pickup Dates** for works not juried into show: Friday, April 1st, 10 am to 4 pm and Saturday, April 2nd, 10 am to 4 pm.

**Entry Fee:** \$5.00 per work, up to five entries. Fee is not returnable unless Show Committee deems the work as unsuitable. Maximum of three works will be accepted into show -- a minimum of one work will be accepted.

**Sales at Show:** A 10% commission will be taken by Beaver Valley Artists on all sales. **All work must remain hanging for the duration of the show.**

**Awards:** Ribbons, cash and gift certificates.

**Juror:** William DeBernardi received an M.F.A. in painting from Indiana University and a B.F.A. in painting from Penn State. He currently is an Associate Professor in the Art Department of Carlow University, Pittsburgh, PA. William's work has been shown internationally with works residing in private, corporate and museum collections throughout the United States and in France, Italy and Venezuela.

**After Show Pickup Dates:** April 20th – after the BVA critique meeting, Thursday April 21st, and Saturday, April 23rd, between 10 am and 4 pm.
