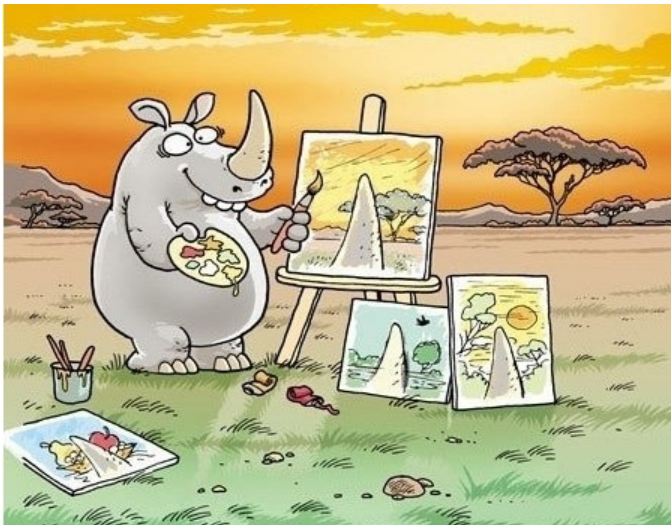


"Fractional Face"



Elizabeth Asche Douglas had artwork accepted into the following exhibitions: *Bridge of Sighs* was in the Southwestern PA Council for the Arts exhibition "History Through Art" at the Greensburg, PA Art Center, July 15-August 26, and won an award. It is a 12" x 12" mixed media on canvas painting. *Dispossessed* and *Kuba Mask on Kente* were in the American Jewish Museum's exhibition "A Painter's Legacy: The Students of Samuel Rosenberg," Feb 5 - April 30 and are reproduced in the full-color catalog published to document the project.

Carol Volz Begley, PSA, PPAL has been accepted into the following national exhibitions: She received first place in the pastel division at the Cape Cod Art Association National Exhibition 2011 and had an oil landscape accepted into juried Cape Fear national exhibition. She also had a pastel landscape accepted into the Chicago Pastel Painters Biennial National Juried Exhibition, "Pastels Chicago".
